



Food Vendors

June 26th 2022, 11-6pm, Nelson Park

1. Food trucks must follow the Town of Plymouth and State laws for food vendors at all times.
2. 10% of gross sales go to Plymouth Pride Inc. (we are a 501c3, EIN 84-3922189)
3. Food trucks must arrive and be completely set up before 10:50 and stay the duration of the festival.
4. Food trucks will be parked in designated spots.
5. Vendors or a representative must remain at the food truck throughout the duration of the festival.
6. Vendors are responsible for the security of their own truck and products.
7. Only approved products and services will be allowed at the festival. (Certain food items may not be sold in order to comply with the current onsite vendor's contract. Ie. No burgers, hotdogs, pizza, kabobs, novelty ice cream, or soft serve. We reserve the right to refuse certain items to be sold.)
8. There is no electrical access for vendors.

9. All food trucks must maintain a professional and festive atmosphere.
10. Food trucks must keep their space clean during and after the festival.
11. No alcohol or smoking in Food Trucks.
12. Breakdown begins at 6 p.m. **No earlier.** Please vacate the grounds by 7:30 p.m.
13. Please check in at the Plymouth Pride tent upon arrival where you will be given your location.

The festival will be rain or shine. There will be no refunds for severe weather, natural disasters, or emergencies.
