## Vendor information For Plymouth Pride Fest 2023

\*Please check in at the Plymouth Pride tent upon arrival where you will be given your location.

1. Vendor setup begins on June 25th, 2023 at 8 a.m. and must be completed by 10:50 a.m.
2. No vehicles will be allowed to park within the vendor space.
3. All vehicles must be unloaded and parked off-site immediately.
4. There is parking off-site for one vehicle.
5. Vendors will be provided with a numbered spot. 12x12
6. Vendors must provide their own tents, tables, chairs, and weights. Plymouth Pride does not provide any tents, tables, chairs, or weights. Nor is there any storage on site.
7. All tents must be properly weighted. Everything must be properly secured. No stakes can be used in the vendor area. Nelson Park is on the ocean and could be quite windy, please plan accordingly.
8. Vendors, or their representatives, must remain at the booth for the festival's duration.
9. Vendors are responsible for the security of their own booths and products.
10. Only approved products and services will be allowed at the festival.
11. There is no electrical access for vendors.
12. All vendor booths must maintain a professional and festive atmosphere.
13. Vendors must keep their space clean during and after the festival. Please carry your trash out with you.
14. No alcohol or smoking in booths.
15. Breakdown begins at 5 p.m. **No earlier.** The booth must be fully broken down and packed prior to bringing the vehicle back to the lot. Please vacate the grounds by 6:30 p.m.
16. Each Vendor Booth is automatically entered in our "Most Prideful Tent" contest. Please decorate your tent- our judges will come around during the festival to pick our winner!
