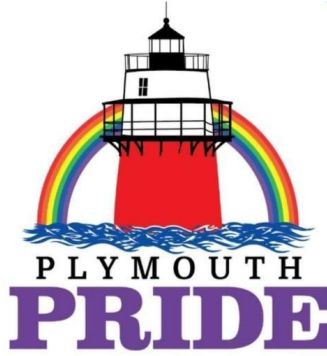

Vendor information For Plymouth Pride Fest 2022

*Please check in at the Plymouth Pride tent upon arrival where you will be given your location.

1. Vendor set up begins on June 26th, 2022 at 8 a.m. and must be completed by 1050 a.m.
2. No vehicles will be allowed to park within the vendor space.
3. All vehicles must be unloaded and parked off site immediately. Vendor space may be set up after parking.
4. There is designated parking for vendors, you will be given directions and a small pass that must be displayed in your vehicle for the duration of the festival. There is no onsite parking except for certain circumstances.
5. Vendors will be provided a numbered 12x12 spot.
6. Vendors must provide their own tents, tables, chairs, and weights. Plymouth Pride does not provide any tents, tables, chairs or weights. Nor is there any storage on site.
7. All tents must be properly weighted. Everything must be properly secured. No stakes can be used in the vendor area. Nelson Park is on the ocean and could be quite windy, please plan accordingly.
8. Vendor or representative must remain at the booth for the duration of the festival.
9. Vendors are responsible for the security of their own booth and products.
10. Only approved products and services will be allowed at the festival.
11. There is no electrical access for vendors.
12. All vendor booths must maintain a professional and festive atmosphere.
13. Vendors must keep their space clean during and after the festival. Please bring your trash with you.
14. No alcohol or smoking in booths.
15. Breakdown begins at 6 p.m. **No earlier.** Booth must be fully broken down and packed prior to bringing vehicle back to the lot. Please vacate the grounds by 7:30 p.m.
16. Each Vendor Booth is automatically entered in our "Most Prideful Tent" contest. Please decorate your tent, our judges will come around during the festival to pick our winner!

The festival will be rain or shine. There will be no refunds for severe weather, natural disasters, or emergencies.
